Registration:

To register as a participant of the conference, please download the registration form from the Conference site, fill it out and send to the e-mail address: ginsbras_conf@mail.ru by January 20, 2026.

Russian, English

Submission of reports:

Duration of *the plenary report is 30 minutes*, *sectional* -20 *minutes*, including time for answering questions. A computer with a multimedia projector is provided to demonstrate the material. When preparing an electronic presentation, we recommend using the MS PowerPoint program. The use of other programs should be agreed in advance with the Organizing Committee. The recommended poster size for the poster session is A0 (841 mm $\times 1189$ mm in portrait orientation).

Requirements for articles:

Abstracts of the conference reports will be published in the form of a collection, assigned ISBN and listed in the national bibliographic database of the Russian Science Citation Index.

Abstracts are accepted until February 1, 2026 via e-mail <u>ginsbras_conf@mail.ru</u> (be sure to ask for confirmation of deliver).

Abstracts are accepted in the form prepared for printing as an attached file in the format *.doc or *.docx. The name of the attached file with an abstract should correspond to the surname of the first author in Latin transcription, the section number should be mentioned. For example, a file should be named *Petrov_7.doc* or *Petrov_7.docx*.

Abstracts are expected to be no more than 2 pages (A4), including figures, tables and references. The text is typed in the Microsoft Word in Times New Roman Cyr, 12, single line spacing, width alignment. An indent of 1 cm is made at the beginning of each paragraph. Margins: upper and lower -2 cm, left -2.5 cm, right -1 cm; centering of

headings and division into paragraphs are performed using Word tools, page numbers are not put down, word wrapping is not allowed.

The abstract title is typed in Times New Roman Cyr, Bold, Center, 12. Initials and surname of the author(s) are typed in Times New Roman Cyr, Norm, Center, 12. A space is placed between the initials and the surname. The name of the author submitting the report is underlined. The name of the organization, the city and the country where the organization is located, the e-mail address of the author are typed in Times New Roman Cyr, Italic, Center, 12.

Tables and figures (at least 300 dpi in size) are inserted directly into the text. Tables, captions to figures and references are typed in Times New Roman Cyr, 10. References to figures and tables are given in parentheses (Fig. 1), (Table. 2); references to literature – in square brackets [1]. The captions to the figures are located below the figure in the center, the captions to the tables are on the top left.

References to the grant and project numbers in which the work was carried out, as well as acknowledgments, are listed after the abstract, before the list of references (Times New Roman Cyr, 10, in italics).

The list of references is generated as references appear in the text and is separated from the text by a line break.
